A.	MUST BE A CURRENT ITLS PROVIDER 1. Must achieve IP status upon taking the written provider test .	<input type="checkbox"/>	Provide copy of your current ITLS card 1. Successfully pass the written exam with a score of 86% or better
B.	PROVIDE TWO LETTERS OF RECOMMENDATION ATTESTING TO TEACHING ABILITY AND WILLINGNESS TO TEACH	<input type="checkbox"/>	Submit two letters of recommendation from community leaders, other educators, students, or employers.
C.	DEMONSTRATE OR SHOW CERTIFICATES OF ADULT EDUCATION INSTRUCTORSHIPS. i.e. ACLS or PALS or TNCC instructor status (current), state EMS instructor etc.	<input type="checkbox"/>	Submit any current instructor cards that you may have or submit documentation that you are a professional educator.
D.	Take the “online instructors course” http://learn.itrauma.org/	<input type="checkbox"/>	Copy course completion to State Coordinator.
E.	Participate in an ITLS orientation as designated by the state coordinator	<input type="checkbox"/>	Discuss with state coordinator what orientation is required.
F.	ONCE ACCEPTED AS A PROVISIONAL ITLS INSTRUCTOR THE CANDIDATE MUST ASSIST AND BE MONITORED IN AT LEAST ONE ITLS COURSE.	<input type="checkbox"/>	Participate in a ITLS class as soon as you can. Once certification is granted, it will be for a 3 year period. You will be expected to teach in at least 2 classes in that time to maintain your instructorship.
