BEHAVIORAL CHANGES Restlessness or combativeness, hyperventilation, unable to breathe.

VISION CHANGES Complete loss or black & white vision, problems concentrating, amnesia, agitation, Post-traumatic Stress Syndrome, hallucinations.

seeing 'stars', blurry, darkness, fuzzy around the eyes.

ringing, buzzing, popping, pressure, tunnel-like hearing. HEARING CHANGES Complete loss of hearing, gurgling,

defecation, loss of strength, going limp. dizziness, headaches, involuntary urination or OTHER CHANGES Memory loss, unconsciousness,






